Visit the Care Opinion website at www.careopinion.org.au and click the 'Tell your story' button.



1. Your story

Story title and content

Enter a title in the ‘*What was your story about*’ box.

Write your story in the ‘*What happened. How did you feel?*’ box. You can type, use voice-to-text (on mobile), or paste from another document.

When did your story happen

Select a general timeframe for your experience.

Using pictures to tell a story

You can use picture tiles to help you to tell your story.

Simply choose the picture that best represents what you want to say, and then drag it up into the white storytelling box and put it to:

- the left (*to say it was good*)
- to the right (*to say it could be improved*)

2. About you

You will be asked **who you are in reference to the story**. Share your **age** (to identify minors for extra care) and **location** (suburb/postcode only) so the platform can make appropriate suggestions for the service provider your experience may be about.
